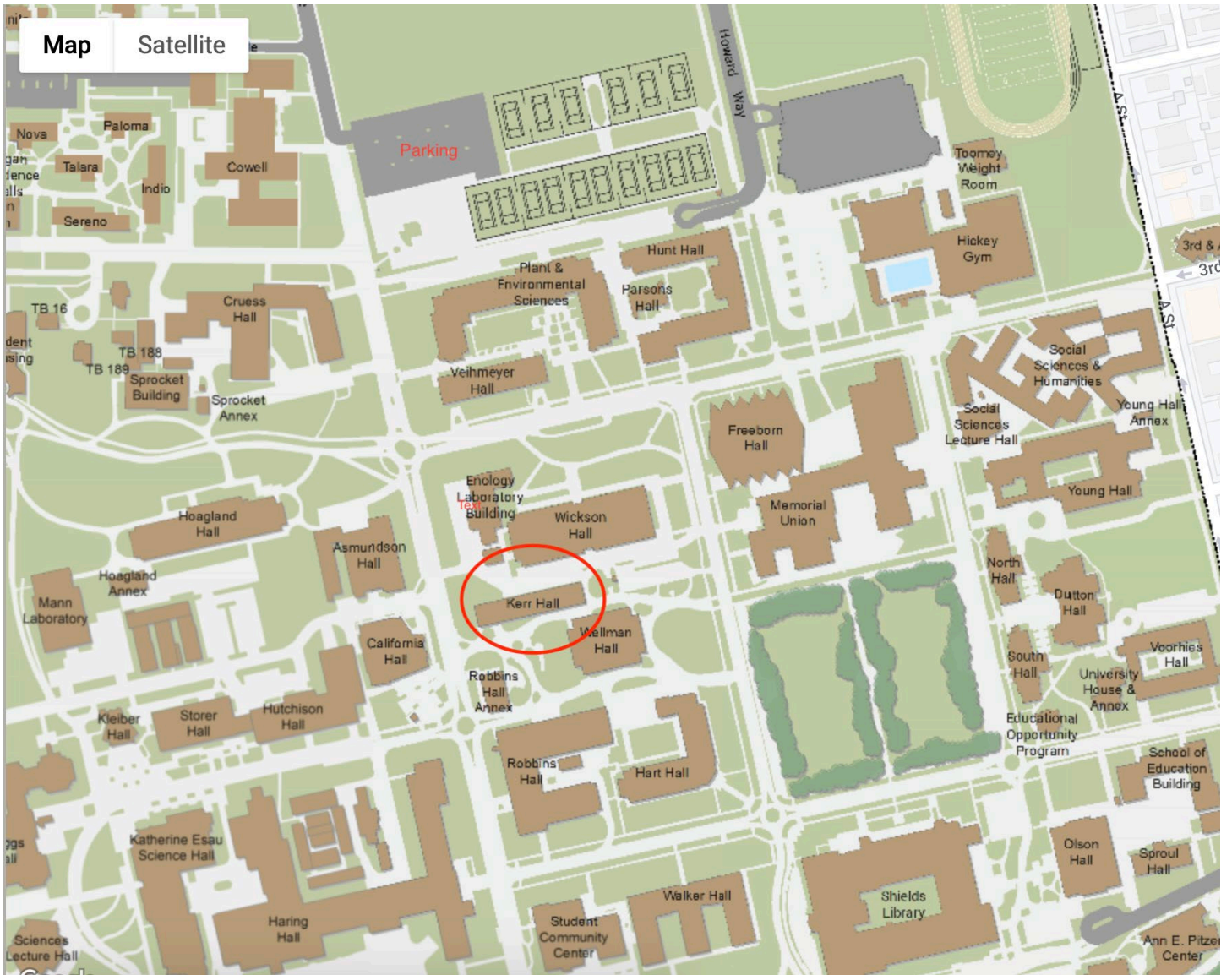

Driving Directions:

Davis is conveniently located off of the I-80 freeway. If coming from points **west**: drive on I-80 E to Exit 70 for 113 N. From 113 N, take exit 28 for Russell Blvd. Turn right (east) onto Russell Blvd. Turn right (south) on California Ave. Visitor Parking (Lot 15) is on your left. <https://goo.gl/maps/jcU7L3n9o2NF9C9t5>

If coming from points **east**: drive on I-80 W to exit 72B for Richards Blvd N toward Downtown. Turn left (west) onto 1st Street. Turn right (north) onto B Street. Turn left (west) onto Russell Blvd. Turn left (south) onto California Ave. Visitor parking (Lot 15) is on your left. <https://goo.gl/maps/AkcNZe3vyE7yZ4Nt6>

Parking is available in Lot 15. You have to create a ParkMobile account to use this lot. Our [parking passes use this system now](#) as the campus no longer offers paper permits. Please let us know if you need to park. We will obtain a pass code which you will have to enter into the Park Mobile site.

Train Directions:

[Capitol Corridor](#) (Amtrak) services Davis. The train station is 0.8 miles from Kerr Hall, a pleasant flat walk through downtown Davis. From the Amtrak station, walk west on 2nd Street through the downtown area. After entering campus, continue west, passing the Memorial Union on your right and the quad on your left. Once past these landmarks Kerr Hall will be on your right. Walking directions are [here](#).

Ground Transport from SMF:

Unfortunately, the public transit from Sacramento Airport (SMF) to Davis is inconvenient. A lengthy [bus route](#) is available. But we recommend taking a taxi or Uber/Lyft to Davis.

Hotel Accommodations:

We have arranged a block of rooms at the [Aggie Inn](#). The group rate is \$157.00 plus tax for a single king room.
